

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to SEC of America dba FLARE Labs ("the Company", "SECA", "FLARE", "FL", "we" "us") and https://machinedossier.net and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to the Company include https://machinedossier.net. The Company website, or web service called Machine Dossier ("MD," "MD Service", or the "Service", is a machine information and reliability web service. By using the Service, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Use of Cookies

The Service may use «cookies» to help you personalize your user experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page.
